- 18. In the event of the Club being wound up, the property and assets of the Club shall not belong to any member but an inventory taken and the proceeds given to a worthy charity and/or local art club(s) nominated by the Committee.

- 4. The Club shall be managed by a committee consisting of a Chairman, Vice-Chairman, Hon Secretary, Hon Treasurer and four Committee Members, who shall be elected at the Annual General Meeting. Four Members shall constitute a quorum.
- 5. The retiring Officers shall not be re-elected "enbloc".
- 6. The Committee shall have the powers to co-opt as considered necessary.
- 7. The Annual General Meeting is normally held in the month of July.
- 8. The Annual Subscription shall be such amount as shall be decided from time to time by the Committee, such amount once decided will remain in force for a minimum of one year, and is payable annually in September or in two instalments in September and March.
